
Bangladesh Embassy in Bangkok Coordinated to repatriate the second group of 78 Bangladesh nationals stranded in Cambodia today by a Biman Bangladesh Airlines repatriation flight

Bangkok, 30 September 2020

Bangladesh Embassy in Bangkok has facilitated the repatriation of the second group of 78 Bangladesh nationals stranded in Cambodia including the mortal remains of a deceased Bangladeshi by a special Biman Bangladesh repatriation flight BG4062 that left Phnom Penh this afternoon in line with the Bangladesh Government's commitment to extend all possible assistance and support for repatriation of stranded Bangladeshis abroad. The flight is scheduled to arrive at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport today afternoon at 04:45 pm. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Bangladesh has arranged this special flight on self-payment basis to repatriate stranded Bangladesh nationals in Cambodia. Bangladesh Embassy in Bangkok has expressed sincere gratitude and thanks towards the Royal Cambodian Government for extending necessary cooperation in departing the stranded Bangladeshi nationals from Cambodia to Bangladesh and also thanked the Bangladesh community in Cambodia for extending all out cooperation for this repatriation flight. Earlier on 07 July 2020, Bangladesh Embassy in Bangkok has facilitated the repatriation of the first group of 57 Bangladesh nationals stranded in Cambodia by a special Biman Bangladesh repatriation flight.

Bangladesh Embassy in Bangkok also facilitated six special repatriation flights from Bangkok to Dhaka on 17 April, 14 May, 23 May, 26 June, 15 July, and 02 September 2020 to send back 242 Bangladesh nationals stranded in Thailand. Officers of the Embassy saw them off at the airport and extended necessary assistance for the departure formalities.
