The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to all Diplomatic Missions, Consular Representatives and International Organisations in Thailand and, with reference to the Ministry's Note No. 0404/C.752 dated 3 May B.E. 2564 (2021) informing that the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration revised the quarantine period for all travellers to enter into the Kingdom of Thailand, has the honour to inform the latter that the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration's Order on 1 October 2021 has recently revised the quarantine period for all travellers who wish to enter the Kingdom of Thailand and the Phuket Sandbox Scheme as follows:

1. Reduced Quarantine Period

1.1 No less than 7 days: Travellers vaccinated with the list of vaccines approved by the Ministry of Public Health of Thailand as follows: (as of 22 September 2021)

- (1) CoronaVac (Sinovac Biotech Ltd.)
- (2) AstraZeneca or Covishield (AstraZeneca & University of Oxford / SK Bioscience (Korea) / Siam BioScience / Serum Institute of India (SII))
- (3) Pfizer – BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine or Comimaty (Pfizer Inc., & BioNTech)
- (4) Janssen or Janssen/Ad26.COV2.S (Johnson & Johnson Services, Inc.)
- (5) Moderna (Moderna Inc.)
- (6) Sinopharm vaccine or COVILO (Sinopharm Co., Ltd.)
- (7) Sputnik V (Gamaleya Research Institute of Epidemiology and Microbiology)

1.2 Travellers must be fully vaccinated for more than 14 days prior to traveling date. Additionally, travellers must present the vaccine certificate (either the original or a printed copy) at the port of arrival. The quarantine period will be determined by the Health Control officers upon arriving in the Kingdom of Thailand.

/ 1.3 No less than...

1.3 No less than 10 days: Travellers without vaccine certificate (or did not receive a full dose of vaccination). The quarantine period will be determined by the Health Control officers upon arriving in the Kingdom of Thailand.

1.4 Travellers under the age of 18 who do not fulfill the vaccination requirements are eligible to undergo the same quarantine period as their guardians should the guardians fulfill all vaccination requirements.

2. **Phuket Sandbox and Samui Plus Scheme**

As of 1 October 2021, travellers from all countries and territories are now eligible to enter the Kingdom of Thailand via the Phuket Sandbox and Samui Plus Scheme as long as they have all the required documents and satisfy all criteria of the sandbox programme.

3. **Other Required Documents**

For entry into the Kingdom of Thailand, the Fit to Fly/Fit to Travel health certificate is no longer required. However, all other relevant documents are still required including, but not limited to, Certificate of Entry (COE), and a medical certificate with RT-PCR laboratory result with the validity of 72 hours prior to departure indicating that COVID-19 is not detected (COVID-Free).

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs avails itself of this opportunity to renew to all Diplomatic Missions, Consular Representatives and International Organisations in Thailand the assurances of its highest consideration.
